


# Using The Library Catalog:

# Catalog: The Basics

- The Library Catalog is used to find materials the Library owns (e.g. books, DVDs, eBooks, etc.)
- The SJR State Library is a part of the Florida College and University Library system.
- Because SJR State is part of the Florida College and University Library system, the students at this college are able to search for and request materials (mainly books) from any of the 40 state institutions of Florida.
- To begin, log into MySJRstate and locate the Library tab





# Points to Remember!

1. When working with the catalog, the results are displayed with the most recently published materials first in A to Z order of the titles. This also means that unlike a search engine (e.g. Google, Bing, etc.), the best results aren't necessarily on the first page or two. Looking in through 7 to 8 pages of a search can still provide relevant materials. Just remember to watch the years and make sure the material is current enough for your paper.
2. How you describe a subject will effect your results. If you are looking for materials about kids in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade, it would be more productive to search for "children" and "elementary education."
3. Always check the Subject area on the records of items you are interested in. There may be other subject headings that are related, but didn't occur to you to try searching.
